FRESH START PROGRAM

When I make bad choices, I have no control over the consequences.

This program's objective is to help prevent juveniles from committing future crimes by allowing them to:

- experience real life jail conditions
- exposing them to the emotional hardships while in jail
- showing them the judicial consequences of criminal acts.

The Fresh Start Program is operated by, School Resource Officers, in conjunction Detention Deputies, of the Charlotte County Sheriff's Office.



For at-risk students ages 10 - 18

Little to no criminal history (Students with civil citations, Notice to Appears, or first-time offenses are acceptable on a case-by-case basis).

Conducted at 8:00AM on a to-be designated Saturday depending on participation and generally runs about 4 hours.

Juveniles must be signed up and liability waiver is required prior to entry.
