- ☐ **Breakfast Club Leader:** *On campus at 8:00 a.m. Students in grades 1-5.* Breakfast Club members help in the cafeteria during breakfast each morning: hand out straws, napkins and utensils, sweep and wipe down tables.
- ☐ **Green Team Recycling Leader:** *On campus Wednesdays at 7:45 a.m. Students in grades 2-5.* Green Team Recycling Team leaders collect paper for recycling from the classrooms and take it to the dedicated container.
- ☐ **Family Reading Experience Event Leader:** *On campus Wednesdays at 7:45 a.m. Students in grades 2-5.* Event leaders will be trained to serve in a leadership capacity accepting such job responsibilities as Greeter, Book Check-out Assistant, Tour Guide, and Prize Distributor. Event Staff will also assist in maintaining an orderly and inviting atmosphere for our visiting families.
- ☐ **Evening Event Leader:** *Work at Family Involvement Events as needed. Students from grades 2-5.* Assist at events such as: Science Night, Math Night, Cougar Carnival, etc. under the supervision of an adult.
- ☐ **Public Speaking Leader:** *Speakers for various school events as needed. Students from any grade.* Introduce, narrate, and close at various events. Record automated phone messages.
- ☐ **Learning Leader:** *Serve as an academic and leadership mentor to a student in grades K-3. Students from grades 3-5.* Mentors will work one-on-one with another student on a weekly basis helping with academics and modeling the 7 Habits. Mentors will attend an orientation prior to the start of their leadership position.
- ☐ **A.M. Safety Leader:** *On campus at 8:00 a.m.*  
**P.M. Safety Leader:** *Remain on campus until 3:20 p.m. FIFTH GRADE STUDENTS ONLY.*  
The Safety Leader's job is to remind students of safety rules learned in the classroom. Safety Leaders monitor students around campus and during parent drop off and pick up. Patrols receive instructions in guidelines and procedures.
- ☐ **News Crew Leader (CPN):** *On campus at 8:30 a.m. FIFTH GRADE STUDENTS ONLY.*  
8 students are fully trained to work at each of 6 stations (Anchors, Camera Operators, Video Operators, Sound Board Operators, Video Graphics Technicians, and Teleprompter Operators) to assist with the school announcements; broadcasted live throughout the school via closed circuit T.V. each morning.
