

PGMS REMINDERS

-All students are required to wear their badge with a breakaway lanyard. If they do not have one, they need to report to the school store prior to period 1. After the second replacement, student's will be charged \$5.00.

-Students may arrive on campus at 8:35 am. Boys and Girls Club is available if you need to drop off your student earlier than 8:35am. They also have afterschool care.

-We are strongly enforcing dress code per our district's Code of Conduct.

-Be sure to log into your FOCUS Parent Portal and complete this year's forms- Emergency forms, current contact information etc. This is also where you view child's grades and attendance

Parent Pick Up Procedures

- Students at dismissal will line up in three to four rows parallel to the car lanes; while in line, students will maintain proper physical distance.
- Prior to students being allowed to enter their vehicle, parents should text their student(s), telling them which numbered zone they have arrived at. Zones are marked on poles on the right-hand side of PPU.
- The first whistle (two quick whistles), releases students to enter their respective vehicle.
- Once all students are loaded, school officials in charge of PPU will whistle again (one long whistle) to signal that it is now safe for all loaded cars to proceed.
- Following the second whistle, the entire pickup line moves forward to initiate the next loading sequence.

WHERE'S THE BUS®

Where's the Bus® allows you to see the location of your child's bus on your smartphone, tablet, or PC. Full access is FREE per household on the App Store, Google Play, or at WheretheBus.com.

1. From your computer go to WheretheBus.com.
2. Click on **PARENTS** on the left hand side to setup an account. Read the fine print directions on the web-page.
3. Use the drop down menu to select "**Charlotte County (FL)**".
4. Enter your information.
5. Enter your child's birth date and student ID number.
6. If you have other students in the household you can enter them using the same logon.
7. Confirm these are your students and you're ready to go !!
