



***INNOVATIVE E-LEARNING MODEL TO EXPIRE AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR:  
IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE  
“INNOVATIVE E-LEARNING” MODEL***

Charlotte County Public Schools will close the Innovative E-Learning Model at the end of the 2020-2021 school year. All students participating in the Innovative E-Learning Model will automatically return to in-person learning at their presently enrolled brick-and-mortar school. There is no action required by parents and guardians in order for this transition to occur.

Parents and guardians may contact the brick-and-mortar school with questions regarding beginning of the school year events or visit the school’s website for additional information. Questions regarding registering students for courses and building the student’s 2021-2022 course schedule are to be directed to the student’s school counselor.
