I am calling with an important message for parents and guardians.

The Commissioner of Education has instructed School Districts to prepare for the possibility to implement an Instructional Continuity Plan if schools must remain closed for an extended period. This means students would need technology at your homes to continue to do their coursework regardless of grade level. In order to implement this plan, the School District must know what parents and guardians have available at their home. We will be placing a survey on our District website later this week to gather this information. We will send another phone message to let you know when the survey is open.

No decision has been made, yet by the Commissioner as to how long the students will be out of school. As soon as that decision is made, I will get the information to you.

Charlotte County Schools will continue to do updates through these phone messages as well as placing information on our School and District Websites.
